Subject	Delegating healthcare facilities with the responsibility to ensure that healthcare practitioners meet the requirements of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) courses.

“Greetings from the Department of Healthcare Professions (DHP),”

As part of the ongoing evaluation process conducted by the department on its regulatory policies in accordance with international best practices, and in its commitment to distribute responsibilities in a manner that serves the interests of the healthcare sector and patient safety, DHP announces the full delegation of responsibility to healthcare facilities to ensure that their staff of healthcare practitioners undergo CPR courses in accordance with the department's policy.

Therefore, healthcare practitioners must meet the requirements of CPR courses according to the established policy. However, they are not required to submit any of these courses in their licensure/renewal applications. Each healthcare facility is obligated to maintain a record containing information and documents related to the completion of these courses by practitioners and provide this information to DHP upon request for auditing purposes.
