Subject	Rejection of training/work under supervision from healthcare practitioners without obtaining a prior approval from DHP

Greetings from the “Department of Healthcare Professions (DHP)”,

In line with DHP's responsibility to improve the healthcare sector in the State of Qatar, and in its commitment to organizing the necessary procedures to ensure patient safety and the competency of healthcare practitioners; it is mandatory for any healthcare practitioner, before commencing a training/ work under supervision period — whether to complete the required years of practical experience or to cover a period of a break in practice — to obtain prior approval from the DHP.

In the event that any training or work under supervision begins without obtaining the mentioned approval, it is considered a violation of the regulations; and any training completion certificates will not be accepted under any circumstances. In addition to that, necessary actions will be taken as deemed appropriate by DHP's management in the event of discovering any trainee not adhering to the established policy.
