1. Who is required to participate in the CPD Program?

Who is required to participate in the CPD Program?

- **All licensed healthcare practitioners (except resident and fellow physicians and dentists in structured training) in part-time or full-time practice are required to participate in the CPD program for sustaining (renewal of) licensure.**

FAQ

Are non-practicing clinicians in the State of Qatar required to participate in the CPD Program?

- Exemptions from participating in the CPD Program are only granted to healthcare practitioners who are **retired** from clinical practice and **non-licensed**.
- **Licensed** healthcare practitioners who do not have clinical care roles but are **engaged in healthcare administration, research or education** must participate in the CPD Program.

FAQ

Are healthcare Practitioners in training required to participate in the CPD program?

All licensed healthcare practitioners (**including healthcare practitioners in training**) are required to participate in the National CPD program **EXCEPT Resident and Fellow healthcare practitioners (Physicians & Dentists)** in structured training programs.



2. National CPD Framework

QCHP-AD: CPD Framework

Learning activities are organized into three categories:

- Category 1: Accredited Group Learning Activities
- Category 2: Self-Directed Learning Activities
- Category 3: Assessment Activities

- **Category 1 Activities include:**
 - Conferences, symposia, seminars and workshops
 - Educational Rounds (examples are Grand Rounds, morning reports, M&M, case-based discussions)
 - Journal Clubs
 - Online synchronous OR blended learning activities.
- **Credit Rating:**
 - 1 credit per hour of participation
- **Supporting Documentation:**
 - Certificate of Attendance from the responsible organization

FAQ

Is attendance at international conferences / international activities outside the State of Qatar accepted?

- **Yes**, CME/CPD activities attended outside Qatar **and** are **accredited by QCHP-AD-recognized international accrediting bodies** can be included within the CPD Framework.
- **A list of QCHP-AD-recognized international accreditation bodies** is published on QCHP-AD website and can be accessed from Practitioners' e-portfolio.

FAQ

Can live webinars be considered as Category 1 activities?

Yes, Live synchronous interactive webinars accredited by **QCHP-AD or QCHP-AD accredited providers (if broadcasted from Qatar) or **QCHP-AD-recognized international accreditation** body (if broadcasted from outside Qatar) can be recognized as Category 1 - Online synchronous OR blended learning activities and can be recorded in your e-portfolio (as long as its submission is supported by required documentation).**

FAQ

How can I know that a group learning activity that I attended (or going to attend) will be recognized by QCHP-AD as Category 1 activity?

All accredited activities (in the state of Qatar) are processed and **published on a list on QCHP-AD website and can be accessed from Practitioners' e-portfolio.**

In addition, the **certificate of participation** in any QCHP-AD accredited activity shall clearly mention an accreditation statement and has QCHP logo.

FAQ

In a Category 1 activity I attended, I spent 7 hours and I was given a certificate that stated that the activity is accredited for 5 hours only. How many hours can I record in my e-portfolio?

You are only allowed to record the credit hours granted to you in the certificate of activity attendance.



FAQ

Can I claim credits for working/clinical rounds?

- **No.** Typically, working/clinical rounds are not formal CPD activities. Rather, they are **bedside visits** by a healthcare practitioner—to evaluate treatment, assess current course and document the patient's progress or recuperation.
- Only **accredited learning rounds** (e.g. morning report in healthcare facilities, Grand rounds, Morbidity and Mortality rounds, tumor boards and case-based discussions) that have met the QCHP-AD CPD activity accreditation standards are eligible for credit under Category 1.

FAQ

Can I record participation in non-accredited group learning activities as category 2 or 3?

- **No. Group learning activities that are not accredited** by QCHP-AD, QCHP-accredited provider or QCHP-recognized international accreditation body (if conducted outside Qatar) **will not be accepted** to be recorded under Category 1, 2 or 3 of the National Framework.

FAQ

Can I record online activities certified by American Medical Association (AMA) as AMA PRA Category 1 as a QCHP Category 1 activity?

- **Categorization of AMA credits is different** than that followed by QCHP.
- **AMA PRA Category 1 activities** include **live activities** (attended in person or remotely as is the case of teleconferences or live Internet webinars) and **other types of activities** (e.g. Enduring materials, Journal-based CME, etc.).
- Only **Live AMA PRA Category 1 activities provided by U.S.-based accredited CME providers** are **eligible** to be recorded in e-Portfolio as **QCHP Category 1 activities**.
- **Other types of AMA Category 1 activities** may be recorded as **QCHP Category 2**.

FAQ

Under which type of QCHP Category 2 shall I record online activity certified as AMA PRA Category 1?

- There are **different types of AMA PRA Category 1 activities** (other than live activities) that can be **recognized as QCHP Category 2**, each in a distinctive Category 2 activity type as follows:

FAQ

How can I record UpToDate CPD activities?

- Completed **UpToDate CPD activities** can be recorded in the e-Portfolio under Category 2 > Clinical Practice > **Answering self-identified questions.**
- You are required to attach a **cumulative certificate of completed reading hours** from UpToDate for each submission.
- If **more than one submission** of UpToDate CPD activities is going to be made, **evidence (certificates)** must be for different date ranges (i.e. **must not include overlapping date ranges**).
- **Each submission is granted 0.5 credits for each hour reading / certified.**

FAQ

How can I record my reading of a journal article or book chapter as CPD?

- You may record reading journal article or book chapter under **Category 2 > Clinical practice > Reading journal article, book chapter or monograph.**
- You need to **fill in the reflection part** and answer the required questions carefully to reflect the learning and professional development you completed.
- You need to **attach an abstract or full text** of the journal article, book chapter or monograph as your supporting document. You may also attach a document with the **reference or source of reading** (e.g. web link).
- **Each recorded activity will automatically be allocated 1 credit by the e-portfolio.**

FAQ

I watched/listened to a recorded video/audio educational material. How can I record it in my ePortfolio?

- The CPD Framework considers watching/listening to recorded educational material (webcasts & podcasts) as category 2>clinical practice> **viewing webcasts or podcasts.**
- You are required to attach the certificate of completion (if applicable), a summary of the activity, a link to the activity or similar evidence, as a supporting document.
- You need to record the exact time spent in listening to/watching the podcast/webcast **(for a maximum of 2 hours per each submission)** and the **system will automatically grant 0.5 credits per hour of participation.**

FAQ

I am involved in a post-graduate study program. Can I record this as CPD? What exactly to record?

- Enrollment in a Postgraduate degree or diploma program recognized by a relevant professional body is recognized by the National CPD Framework as CPD.
- You may record each Semester/Course of the program **that coincides with your CPD cycle** as Category 2 - Self-Directed Learning Activity.
- **You are allowed to record a maximum of three semesters/ courses per each submission.**
- **Note that, Sitting for board or fellowship exams, however, without actual enrollment in a post-graduate study program CANNOT be recorded under this activity type**

FAQ

Can I claim credits for teaching or giving presentations?

- **Teaching or giving presentation per se is not granted CPD credits.**
- **You may**, however, **record** the time you spent **learning** (acquiring new knowledge or skills) **while preparing for formal teaching activities** under Category 2 - Self-Directed Learning Activities / Education and Training / preparation for formal teaching activities.
- “Preparation for formal teaching” submission **must be documented by attaching a teaching schedule from the responsible organization** (including the presentation/lecture title, date, duration and speaker name).
- **Notes**
 - **Credit hours claimed** must be **for the estimated time spent learning** while preparing for the formal teaching and **NOT the time spent delivering your presentation or teaching sessions.**
 - **Recorded** hours for preparation for formal teaching activities **cannot exceed double the duration of the presentation itself.**
 - Each submission is granted **2 credits for each hour preparation for formal teaching activities.**

FAQ

How do I record mentoring students as a CPD activity?

- You may record the time you spent “preparing” for mentoring students under Category 2 - Self-Directed Learning CPD Activity / Education and training / **preparation" for mentoring students, trainees or peers.**
- Participation in mentoring activities **must be documented by a letter from the responsible organization.**
- **The maximum time allowed to be recorded in your e-portfolio for preparation for mentoring is 10 hours per year of CPD Cycle; that is a maximum total of 20 hours per CPD cycle.**

FAQ

Can I claim credits for publishing articles/books?

- Healthcare practitioners may claim credits for developing **peer-reviewed publications** under Category 2 > Research and Quality Improvement> Development of a research grant or peer reviewed publications.
- This **may include** peer-reviewed journal articles, book chapters or similar publications (e.g. a peer-reviewed conference presentation or poster that is published in a conference proceedings).
- **Hours/Credits are allocated automatically by the e-portfolio based on the authorship ranking.** First author is granted 10 Hours/Credits, second author is granted 5 Hours/Credits while other authors are granted 3 Hours/Credits.

FAQ

I was in a committee that peer-reviewed the clinical practice of one or more healthcare practitioners. How do I record this in my ePortfolio?

- Healthcare practitioners may claim credits for **peer-reviewing the clinical practice of other healthcare practitioner(s)** under Category 2 > Research and Quality Improvement> Peer review of a clinical practice.
- This must be **documented by an official letter form the responsible organization** describing the review task(s) assigned, the date of task completion and the estimated number of hours spent in peer-reviewing.
- Healthcare practitioners must record the exact time spent in peer-reviewing (**for a maximum of 4 hours per task/activity submission**).

FAQ

I peer reviewed a journal article. How can I claim CPD credits for this activity?

- Healthcare practitioners may claim credits for **peer-reviewing journal articles** under Category 2 > Research and Quality Improvement> Peer review for journals or research grants.
- **This must be documented by an official letter form the responsible organization (Journal publisher).**
- Healthcare practitioners must record the exact time spent in peer-reviewing (**for a maximum of 3 hours per task/activity submission**).

FAQ

How many credits can I record as “Feedback from annual performance review” or “Feedback on teaching effectiveness”?

You may record only the **time you spent getting or receiving feedback from your employer** (in case of feedback on your annual performance) or from the **organization-assigned reviewer** (in case of feedback on your teaching effectiveness) **for a maximum of 1 hour per activity submission.**



3. National CPD Program Requirements

QCHP-AD: CPD Requirements

- **CPD Cycle Duration: 2 years**
- **CPD cycle start date** will be individualized to **align with date of licensure.**
- **CPD Cycle Requirements** (**minimums** and not maximums)
 1. **Annual CPD requirements**
 - 40 credits each year.
 2. **CPD cycle requirements**
 - 80 credits over two years
 3. **Category-specific requirements**
 - 40 credits in Category 1, and
 - 40 credits across Category 2 and/or Category 3 (in any combination).

Leave Policy

- Policy is **applicable for all healthcare practitioners in eligible leaves.**
- Being in **eligible leave adjusts cycle and category-specific CPD Credit requirements.**
- To be **eligible**, leave must be:
 - ✓ **Other than** Annual and casual leave.
 - ✓ For, **at least, 30 (thirty) consecutive days** within the license renewal period.
 - ✓ **Approved by** the concerned authority (**employer**) of the practitioner.
 - ✓ Filed correctly and **approved by the registration department** of QCHP.
- Leave must be **submitted to QCHP after its end or at license renewal date** (whichever is sooner).

FAQ

Can I submit my CPD credits before the due date for license renewal?

- **Yes.** Submission of credit is **open 3 months before** license expiry date (due date for license renewal) and **until the expiry date itself.**
- Once you complete the CPD credit requirements, you may submit the CPD credits and proceed with license renewal during this period.
- This **does not mean that you have to submit** your CPD credit requirement 3 months before license expiry.

FAQ

I got my first License to practice on March 30, 2018 and I am trying to record a CPD activity I completed two months before I got my license (as advised by my licensed colleagues) yet the system doesn't allow me to record activities before March 30, 2018. Is this a system glitch?

- **No. Recording activities** you completed before issuing your first license, in the e-Portfolio, **is not allowed.**
- **Credit transfer** for CPD activities completed in the immediate 6 months prior to first license issuance **was temporarily allowed** (as per CPD Credit Transfer Policy) for **the first two years** of the National CME/CPD Program implementation **ONLY.**
- **CPD Credit Transfer Policy expired on March 7, 2018.** Therefore, any HCP who got his/her first license issued after that date cannot record any CPD activities completed before the date of his/her license issuance in his/her e-Portfolio.

FAQ

I completed more credits than required for my CPD cycle. Can the remaining credits be transferred to my next CPD cycle?

No. Credit transfer is not allowed between CPD cycles.

FAQ

My license expires May 31st 2017. I completed all credits required for my CPD cycle and I submitted my credits for license renewal on March 15th 2017. I am planning to attend a workshop on April 23rd 2017. Can I record the credits I gain into my next CPD cycle?

No. Only Credits completed during the CPD cycle are allowed to be recorded by the e-portfolio.

FAQ

My license expires May 31st 2017. I completed all credits required for my CPD cycle and I submitted my credits for license renewal on May 30th 2017. I am planning to attend a workshop on June 2nd 2017 and my license might not be renewed yet. Can I record the credits I gain into my next CPD cycle?

Yes. If you fulfilled all the requirements for license renewal and applied for it on time, your new license (and hence CPD cycle) will be granted for 2 years from of previous license expiry. You will be able to record any activity completed during your new CPD cycle.

FAQ

I participate in the CPD Program outside of the State of Qatar. Will you accept my participation in this program to maintain my licensure with the Ministry of Public Health?

No. Once launched, all healthcare practitioners licensed to practice in the State of Qatar must participate in the QCHP CPD Program to maintain their Ministry of Public Health license to practice. **However**, participation in CPD activities outside Qatar that are accredited by international accreditation bodies that QCHP-AD recognizes can be recorded in your e-portfolio.

FAQ

Will my participation in CPD activities accredited by QCHP-AD be recognized by other regulatory authorities and CPD systems abroad?

- Currently, Qatar's National **Credit system is recognized** by the American Medical Association (**AMA**), the American Academy for Family Physicians (**AAFP**) and the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (**RCPSC**). CPD credits granted from participation in one of QCHP-AD-accredited activity types (covered by the agreements) will be recognized by the Credit systems of such organizations. In addition, by a unique agreement, RCPSC will recognize fulfillment of QCHP-AD CPD cycle requirements as equivalent and substitutive for participation in the RCPSC's MOC program.
- Qatar's National CME/CPD **Accreditation system is** also recognized as **substantially equivalent** to the accreditation systems of the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (**ACCME®**) and The Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (**RCPSC**).




4. Documentation of CPD Activities

Documentation of CPD Activities

- Every healthcare practitioner is required to maintain an individual **CPD activity record**, which will constitute his/her CPD ePortfolio:
 - Record details of **completed** learning activities.
 - Record **reflections** on learning for practice.
 - Upload the **documentation** as defined by the CPD Framework-where applicable.
- A CPD portfolio also includes a **planning department** – to state the individual learning needs identified.



All healthcare practitioners in part-time or full-time practice in the State of Qatar are required to complete the annual and CPD cycle specific requirements to maintain their registration and renewal of licensure.

Credit Transfer Policy

The credit transfer policy is only applicable to a healthcare practitioner's first CPD cycle, regardless of the length of the first CPD cycle.

All healthcare practitioners are responsible for reporting their completed CPD learning activities in the QCHP-AD CPD ePortfolio. All completed CPD activities must be selfreported in the CPD ePortfolio no later than the date of registration each year.

5. Monitoring Compliance to the National Program

Monitoring Compliance

- The QCHP-AD has established a **CPD audit process** for healthcare practitioners.
- It is a process that **reviews the documentation/validation** established for all learning activities included in the CPD framework and self-reported in the portfolio.

Monitoring Compliance

- Healthcare practitioners who **fail to meet the minimum annual requirement** of 40 credits are **deemed to be non-adherent** and will be:
 - **Notified** at the end of the first year for non-adherence.
 - **Provided with information** on how to seek assistance.
 - Required to participate in a CPD ePortfolio **Audit**.
- Healthcare practitioners who fail to record the **minimum expectations for Category-specific or 2-year CPD Program cycle** requirements will be **deemed to be non-compliant** and will be subject to having their registration and licensure in the State of Qatar terminated for non-compliance (with opportunity to appeal).

CPD Appeals - CPD Cycle Closure Appeal

- Healthcare practitioners who are **deemed to be noncompliant** with CPD Program cycle requirements may request an opportunity to appeal their non-compliance.
- Appeal is made by completing and submitting “**CPD Cycle Closure Appeal Request Form**” to the QCHP-AD within **30 days** of the healthcare practitioners being notified they are noncompliant with CPD cycle requirements.
- **A review panel**, facilitated by the QCHP-AD, will be formed to assess any CPD Program cycle appeals submitted by healthcare practitioners.
