“Registration Department in Qatar Council for Healthcare Practitioners presents to you its compliments”

In the Qatar Council’s pursuit to organize the procedures of registration/ licensing process for healthcare practitioners; kindly be advised that healthcare practitioners who are working in the governmental sector and had the old (**Paper Medical License**) before the launch of QCHP new electronic registration system on 15/3/2011, and they have not renewed their licenses till the date of this circular. These practitioners must apply for registration on the system and their applications will be treated as **renewal applications** in terms of requirements under the following conditions:

1. Attach the old paper license.
2. The healthcare practitioner must be on job up to date in that institution without any break.
3. If the practitioner is moving to the private sector, then they must meet the current QCHP registration and licensing requirements.

Accordingly, all healthcare practitioners who have (Paper Medical License) must contact their focal point in their institution in order to complete the registration process to benefit from this policy before the end of June 2018.
