In alignment with the increased number of registration / licensing applications of healthcare practitioners working in the above mentioned facilities, and in order to avoid any delays in processing these applications; the Registration Department will recognize the period of work within the required years of experience for registration / licensing until December 2014 (Coinciding with National Health Strategy project 5.2 output which includes registration and licensing of all healthcare practitioners in the State of Qatar).

In this regard, the Registration Department encourages all the healthcare practitioners working in these facilities who are not registered / licensed to initiate their registration and licensing process immediately, otherwise any unlicensed experience will not be considered after December 2014.
