In alignment with circular no. (01/2016) and circular no. (11/2018) regarding the registration and licensing of healthcare practitioners (Pharmacists/ Nursing/ Allied Healthcare Practitioners) from Qatar university graduates and Qataris and children of Qatari women or residents' offspring who studied abroad, the Department of Healthcare Professions has decided that candidates -from the above mentioned categories planning to join governmental and semi-governmental healthcare facilities- will be exempted from registration/licensing requirement of work experience provided that they complete an internship period as per the educational program requirements.
