Subject	Regulation of number of attempts to pass the Qualifying Exam (Prometric) and the gap between each attempt

The Registration department in Qatar Council for Healthcare Practitioners (QCHP) presents to you its compliments.

In accordance with QCHP's commitment to assure the competency of Healthcare practitioners in the state of Qatar through the procedures of Registration/licensing, and in order to issuing unified policies showing transparency and clarity, and as per Permanent Licensing Committee's decision in its 18th meeting that was held on 14/10/2015, QCHP issued this policy to regulate number of attempts to pass the qualifying exam (Prometric) and the gap between each attempt as following;

- The practitioner can sit for exam for 3 consecutive times, whatever the gap between each attempt.
- In case, the practitioner failed to pass the exam for the third time, he/she will be permitted for two more attempts with six months mandatory gap in each, however, the total number of attempts should not exceed 5.

This policy shall be put into effect as of the issue date, Additionally, Applicants who have exceeded the permitted number of attempts before the date of issuing of that policy, will be treated on case by case basis.
